his island is clearly the focal point of this European style kitchen built for a family in Connecticut.

It was designed to fill and define the large, open space that connects kitchen & family room. In addition, it has a myriad of functions with something in it for everyone. This island has three distinct zones. The attached dining table has a beautiful wood stained finished to differentiate it from the rest of the island.

The buffer portion was created to look like a piece of furniture facing the family room. It can be used to set out whatever is needed when entertaining and has a custom painted faux finish. The copper sink & prep area of the island provides a backdrop that complements the oven's backsplash. It also includes a botcher block table that is on wheels and can be rolled where it's needed. This area is hidden by a taller section that houses a remote controlled pop-up TV that swirels, allowing for viewing from any angle.

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
